With three in the house under the age of 9, Janet and I continue to see the world through a child's eyes. All the magic, wonder and amazement that a child experiences, we get to experience all over again through them.

Recently, in a conversation with Tanner, he told us he was 'thinking smart thoughts.' He told Janet and me that his 'smart' thoughts were about what happens to our food when we swallow. Now, you and I already know, of course. But to a little five year old boy, swallowing is something magical. He said it was funny because you could feel it in your stomach and exactly what happened when you swallow. His perception of the process was purely based on his very limited experience. He was drawing conclusions from his perception.

Isn't that really the difficulty, controlling perception? How can you attract a sinner to a faith that appears to be a restrictive? Further, how do we follow God's will or do we follow our perception of God's will? The answer is an elusive one.

I really think we need to take Tanner's perspective. God's love is a wonder and amazing. We can change the perception of others by showing them the change in us. I can think of a few examples that have happened lately within our own church family as it has grown. Let's show the outside world what real Christianity is through God's love. Maybe that's not such a difficult thing to swallow anyway.
