On Being a Witness

Several years ago while riding with some friends, a wreck occurred in the intersection in front of us. We hung around to make sure no one was hurt. In a minute the police arrived; they asked for statements and witnesses. They depended on someone reliable to tell them exactly what they had seen and what they knew.

Once I was a character witness for a friend who'd plead guilty for a felony. I said to the judge, My friend has plead guilty for this crime; he does not deny committing it, but here is what I know and have seen of his character over the past ten years. I asked that the sentence be fair but 'as kind as possible.'

In the days since Easter we've thought and talked about Jesus' post Resurrection appearances. Over and over again Jesus reminds his followers that they are to be witnesses.

Here's what Jesus said to the disciples in Acts, chapter one:

You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth...

In the 20th chapter of John Jesus appeared to the disciples huddled together in fear and said,

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you."

As Jesus shared a meal with the disciples Luke records:

Jesus opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

This week as we seek to follow Jesus with our lives, may we each accept his call to witness and tell of his goodness!
