**Transfer of Letter**

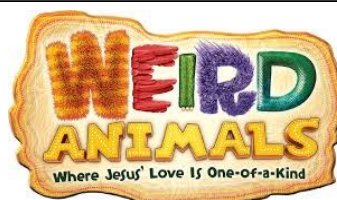
If you belong to another Baptist church, we will be happy to write and ask that your church letter be transferred to FBC.
