FBC on Missions This Summer

The new church year is beginning in September and the church is busy with activity. But throughout the summer, First Baptist has been engaged in ministry.

The youth went to Jonathan Creek and returned with a renewed sense of mission. Several youth and church members went to Louisville for a week of leading Vacation Bible Schools and assisting a mission center in serving those in need. As the summer progressed, the youth cleaned and repainted a home for an elderly man.

Church members provided schools supplies and food items for the backpack ministry. We are expanding our backpack ministry this year, feeding up to 30 children every weekend. In May and June, church members selected "Forget Me Nots" and assured many of our homebound and nursing home residents they were not forgotten. We expanded our food pantry to include a second distribution time on the fourth Monday of each month. It was a good thing because we have had the largest numbers for summer distribution that we have had since I have been working as Food Pantry Director. One Wednesday night, we provided a garden based meal for all the food pantry clients, and they were so appreciative. One week, we took meals out to the Extreme Build group in McCreary County.

We opened our church for Mission Fuge to use for both recreational activities and for mission projects. Large numbers of middle and high school students organized our resource room and food pantry, cleaned chairs and tables, and painted the Christian Life Center. We provided kitchen space for Life Community Church of Virginia as they went out on mission in Whitley County.

This past couple of weeks we welcomed nearly 300 University of the Cumberlands students into our sanctuary and provided a great lunch for them. We spent a Sunday afternoon hauling boxes, bags, refrigerators, and assorted crates into dorm rooms, offering helping hands and reassuring smiles to both incoming students and frazzled parents.

What a blessing to be part of a church that takes the Great Commission to heart, touches lives and makes a difference. May a passion for Christ continue to express itself through love and service to all those we encounter.
