A 'Love' Letter

I take time listening to music for choir. I listen to new musical selections for us to perform, but really, I enjoy listening for myself. I can worship and feel closer to God as I listen to music. It speaks to my soul. As I write this short article, I am listening to a piece called "Beloved, Let Us Love One Another." I will use this one.

When Brileigh was born, I didn't realize the impact that a little girl would make on my family and more profoundly, myself. She was a good baby. No matter how I hurt her feelings, though the words that I speak may be unkind, she still will lay her head on my shoulder and tell me she loves me. It's unconditional.

As a father, it reminds me so much of what I must teach my children. Whether by words or actions, which I am not very good at, we must love God, unconditionally. We must love one another, unconditionally. Love one another as Christ loves His children unconditionally. "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God." 1 John 4:7
