- Specific items needed by the Food Pantry include peanut butter, boxes of Mac & Cheese, and cans of beef stew.
- Backpack meals are meals that go home with children over the weekend to be sure they receive some nutrition while at home. Many children depend upon school for regular meals.
- Specific needs for the Backpack Ministry include non-refrigerated fruit cups, pudding cups, ramen noodles, and Pop Tarts.
