**CAMP FBC: Something different than Vacation Bible School this year! Children, ages kindergarten through 5th grade, will go to camp right here at First Baptist. Mark your calendars for Monday, July 23-Thursday, July 26, 6:00 -8:30 PM.

WORKERS NEEDED: We'll need workers to be a part of Camp FBC. If you would be willing to help in one of the following ways, let Tyler or the church office know ASAP!!

2-Day Commitment (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/ Thursday)

- -Creative Creations: Craft time for four 30 minute segments.
- -Service Showcase: Missions time for four 30 minute segments.

4-day Commitment (Monday-Thursday)

- --*Around the Fire*: This is the Discipleship time where kids will dive deeply into what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. Four 30-minute segments, plus prep work is required.
- --Outdoor Adventures: This is recreation time. All materials and instructions will be given to the leaders. Minimal prep work required for four 30-minute segments.
- --Cabin Leaders: Accompany, cheer on, and prayer with and for the campers every day. No prep work needed.
- --Camp Counselor: In charge of facilitating the opening celebration. Prep work and materials provided. Prep materials do need to be studied well beforehand.
- --Floaters: People willing to be anywhere at a moment's notice.

Behind the Scenes (multi-day commitments)

- *--Canteen Time*: This is snack time. Most prep work can be done beforehand, but we need people there to distribute the snacks.
- --Registration/Check-in: Last minute registration and daily check -in. This will be a 30-minute commitment each day.
- --Decorations: We need help transforming the CLC and select classrooms into a campground. This will need to be completed 2-3 days before camp starts. There will be an organizational/visioning meeting to plan for decorations.
